

## 2016 Anacortes Farmers Market Non-Compliance Policy

The AFM is a market with over 100 registered vendors and up to 3000 daily visitors. It is of the utmost importance that the rules be followed – for the safety and fairness for everyone involved.

It is within the sole discretion of Anacortes Farmers Market to determine if a vendor has violated any rule that breaks a law, city provision, WSFMA guidelines or undermines the smooth operation of the market. Such violations may include, but are not limited to:

- Arriving late
- No call/no show
- Parking in unauthorized areas (see map in vendor packet)
- Packing and/or leaving before close of market (unless given explicit permission)
- Harassment, inappropriate conduct or discrimination of any kind
- Violation of required health or safety laws
- Disposing of trash in market garbage receptacles (use dumpster)
- Not affixing required 25lb weights on each canopy leg
- Hawking – includes walking around with samples
- Selling inappropriate or disallowed products
- Signage or display outside your designated booth space (no A-boards)

Absolutely NO DRUGS or ALCOHOL are to be consumed on premises during operating hours. Smoking within or within 50 feet of market property during operating hours (6am-4pm) is prohibited.

Such failure will result in:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Verbal Warning

2<sup>n</sup> Offense- Written warning

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - \$25 Fine

4<sup>th</sup> Offense Expulsion from the market for remainder of the season (no refunds given)

Employers- your employees are an extension of you. A violation given to an employee applies to you and your business.
